

# INSTRUCTIONS: #GRACETables

1. Download, print, and lay out the cards on the table with the questions facing up.
2. Invite 4 women to grab a question.
3. Take turns having each woman ask the question on her card. Allow time for everyone around the table to share or respond to the question.

## VERSE & QUESTIONS

---

*“And Jesus came and said to them, ‘All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age.’” (Matthew 28:18-20)*

**Challenge:** The enemy would love for you to believe that you’re not qualified to share Jesus with someone else. He would love for you to believe that your past is all people can see, that your gifts aren’t good enough, that you haven’t learned enough, that you’re not loud enough. But God is too good to keep to ourselves. There is no degree, no title, no pay grade necessary to share God with other people. You’re qualified for making disciples because of your relationship with your Creator. It’s not your job to change people, but it is your job to tell them about the greatest news that’s ever been told.

Q1: What does discipleship look like in your life right now? Are you being discipled by another woman? Is there someone you are pouring into?

Q2: Do you feel as though you aren’t qualified for discipleship? Why or why not?

Q3: What preconceived beliefs about discipleship might be holding you back from discipling or being discipled?

Q4: How do you want your current discipleship relationships to grow? Who is someone you can pray about entering into a discipleship relationship with?
